PERSONAL STATEMENT: As President, I would focus on four specific issues.

- Staff positions have been reduced and the number of mandates has been increased. All of our colleagues – no matter what type of contract they have or don't have – deserve an opportunity to grow professionally and contribute to the important work of the Organization of American States.
- 2. The decade-old policy on work place and sexual harassment must be include concrete measures to ensure that all parties are afforded a fair hearing and appropriate sanctions are leveled in a consistent manner.
- 3. The proposals to the General Standards must ensure equal opportunity for staff contracts and retain parity with the UN System. The 2013-2014 Staff Committee, of which I am a part, has provided proposed reforms to the CAAP.
- 4. Competitions including those for continuing contracts need to be made available on regular and equitable basis in accordance with existing rules.

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
