Dear Colleagues,

As I have previously mentioned during my campaign, the period of transition to a new administration always presents opportunities and challenges. It is a time that brings a lot of positive expectations, but also apprehension for the staff of the Organization. In that sense, I believe that the Staff Association plays a fundamental role at this juncture. With the recognition of the value of the human capital of the OAS, Staff will be even more motivated to give their best efforts to implement the new directives and support the new administration.

In this regard, I would like this new term of the Staff Association to be marked by three main principles: **Openness for Dialogue, Transparency and Teamwork**.

Regarding **dialogue**, it should be based on mutual respect and trust among the Staff, the Administration and Member States. We are all invested in the success of this Organization, but this success can only be sustained by a participatory approach to decision-making, where all stakeholders are involved and heard. And I quote Secretary General Almagro on this: "*Es importante preguntar para saber más, porque el que va a la bodega y no bebe, burro fue y burro vuelve*".

There are many pending issues that will require our commitment to sit down and discuss matters that affect the Staff welfare and which will allow us to put the ‘Human’ in the Human Resources of the Organization, such as training and career development for Staff, the prevention of workplace and sexual harassment and *telework*. As well as, the new organizational structure, the suspension of ongoing competitions, the establishment of the Ethics Committee and the role of the ombudsperson.

Regarding **transparency**, as I mentioned during my intervention during the first “Cabildo Abierto” with Secretary General Almagro, I believe the OAS should lead by example in this area. This applies to the Staff Association, as well. In this regard, I will work to continue strengthening the transparency and accountability of our activities. One proposal will be to create a distribution list where those interested can receive copies of the agendas of the meetings of the Staff Committee in advance so they can be informed of what is being discussed and offer input.

The Committee will also continue to report promptly to Staff on activities and strengthen the spaces that allow feedback from staff regarding ideas, suggestions and proposals to improve the work environment of the Organization, including from those who work outside Headquarters.

Regarding **teamwork**, those of you who know me know that this is something I strongly believe in and I wish to emphasize it during our term. In this regard, I look forward to working jointly and in coordination with all the members of the Committee.

We are very mindful of the long and successful history of accomplishments by the Staff Association and will be drawing on that resource through a continuing relationship with the Association of Retirees of the OAS (AROAS) and with the Federation of International Civil Servants Associations (FICSA), as well with several current staff members who have previously served on the Staff Committee and who remain dedicated to the welfare of the Staff. We will also reach out to new volunteers to assist us with different tasks and activities.

In the same vein, the Committee will continue to support projects and initiatives of groups of employees in the areas of sports and culture, including the Soccer Tournament, the 5k Run, the Art Group and the OAS Choir. These activities foster and strengthen the union of the Staff, consultants and interns.

Also, allow me to express that, as a member of the LGBT community, I am particularly sensitive to issues of inclusiveness, equality and accessibility of minority and vulnerable groups in the workplace and will pay particular attention to policies and initiatives that affect these groups.
